- o Exhibits will be judged according to standards set out by the Royal Horticultural Society of NSW.
- o Judging will commence at 10:30am and the Judges decision will be final in all classes.
- o All plants in this section must be grown by and be the property of the exhibitor, for at least 3 months.
- o Entries may be entered at the Horticulture Pavilion at the Showground from 3-6pm Friday and from 8:00am to 10:00am on Saturday morning of the Show.
- o Entries must be collected between 10:00am and 12:00 noon Sunday.
- o Entries not collected by 12:00 noon Sunday will be left outside of Horticulture Pavilion.
- o Points will be awarded for the Most Successful Exhibitors and Runner Up

Please Note: All pots to be no more than 35.5cm (14inches) across top (inside measurements), hanging containers excluded. Only one plant per pot, unless stated otherwise

10. Pot Plant, coloured foliage.
11. Pot Plant, variegated foliage.
12. Green foliage plant.
13. Maiden Hair Fern.
14. Fern in container (variety not mentioned).
15. Begonia in bloom.
16. Begonia, leaf, coloured leaf.
- 17.(a) Pot Plant, Cactus & Succulent 3 or more in a container
- 17(b) Pot Plant Cactus and or succulent one only in container.
18. Pot Plant in bloom.
19. Plant in hanging container --- Succulent.
20. Plant in hanging container --- Fern, any variety.
21. Flowering plant in hanging container.
22. Plant in hanging container --- Not in Bloom.
23. Climbing or Twining Plant, e.g. Ivy
