Young Farmers Challenge

The Young Farmers Challenge is an event which showcases farmers as energetic, hardworking and multi-skilled young men and women. We hope to engage, educate and entertain you with a competition that holds integrity of farmers and the strong established background farming holds in rural NSW. The Young Farmers Challenge is the ultimate test of skill and ability with young farmers showcasing their expertise in a series of farm challenges. We aim to promote safe farming practices, through the appropriate use of farming equipment and handling of livestock throughout the competition.

Rules of The Young Farmers Challenge:

- The Young Farmers Challenge will be run in accordance with the Rules and Regulations as set out by the Royal Agricultural Show Society of New South Wales.
- Animal Welfare Management in this competition will adhere to the Royal Agricultural Society of New South Wales Guidelines for use of live Animals in Challenges.
- All entrants must sign an Agricultural Societies Council of New South Wales Participant Risk Assessment and Waiver Form prior to the commencement of the competition.
- Teams entering the competition must consist of four competitors, both male and female between the ages of 18-35 to be eligible to represent at Sydney Royal Easter Show, however other age groups may enter but will not be able to represent at Sydney Royal Easter Show.
- Entrants must read the rules and regulations of the competition prior to commencement of competition.
- All entrants must wear closed in footwear and suitable clothing. Jeans, collared shirt, boots and hat would be deemed suitable.
- Each team must complete every challenge safely, using the correct PPE, otherwise there will be a penalty of a five point deduction for that section.
- Inappropriate behavior and mishandling of livestock will incur elimination from the competition.
- The winning team will be eligible to represent the Manilla Show Society at the NSW Young Farmers Challenge State Finals at the 2019 Sydney Royal Easter Show.
